

SoftPlan Technical Bulletin

Last Updated: November 8, 2001.

Problem: After upgrading to Windows 2000 or Windows XP, when you attempt to start SoftPlan a message is displayed stating that "The SoftPlan Key Device Driver has not been installed on this system".

Users Effected: SoftPlan version 11 users who upgrade their operating system to Windows 2000 or Windows XP from Windows 95, Windows 98 or Windows ME after having installed SoftPlan.

To Fix: The key device driver used with the previous operating system is not compatible with the new operating system and must be replaced. To do this:

- Insert the SoftPlan cd into your cd-rom drive.
- Using Windows Explorer, move to the System\Sentinel\Win_NT folder.
- Double click on *setupx86.exe* to launch the key driver installer.
- Choose *Remove Sentinel Driver* from the Functions menu.
- Click *OK* when asked Are you sure you want to remove the driver?
- Choose *Install Sentinel Driver* from the Functions menu.
- Click *OK* when asked to Specify the Path of the Sentinel Files.
- Choose *Quit* from the Functions menu.
- Restart your computer.

Note: Users who upgrade their operating system from Windows NT or Windows 2000 to Windows XP are not affected by this problem.
