Problem: Eighths fractional characters appear as a box on screen and do not appear on a print

Users Effected: Users who recently updated an earlier version 13 installation to version 13.4.0 but have not yet installed the separate font patch.

To verify your currently installed version select Help – About SoftPlan.

To Fix:

Changes have been made with version 13.4.0 to allow the eighths fractional characters to properly display on Windows Vista. A separate font patch needs to be installed for these special characters to appear regardless of the operating system being used.

To correct the issue,

- 1. Exit SoftPlan and any other applications that may be opened.
- Select the "Required Font Install for 13.4.0 Patches " link on the version 13 patches webpage at: http://www.softplan.com/techver13patch.htm
- When prompted, select Save and save the patch file to your desktop.
- 4. Once the file has been downloaded, double click on the SP1340Fonts.exe icon on your desktop.
- Follow the on screen prompts to install the patch file.
 NOTE: if you receive an error stating "Access is denied" while running the font patch, restart the computer and run the font patch again.
- 6. After the font patch has finished, restart your computer.

Comment:

This issue does not affect users who install the program directly from a version 13.4.0 installation CD.
